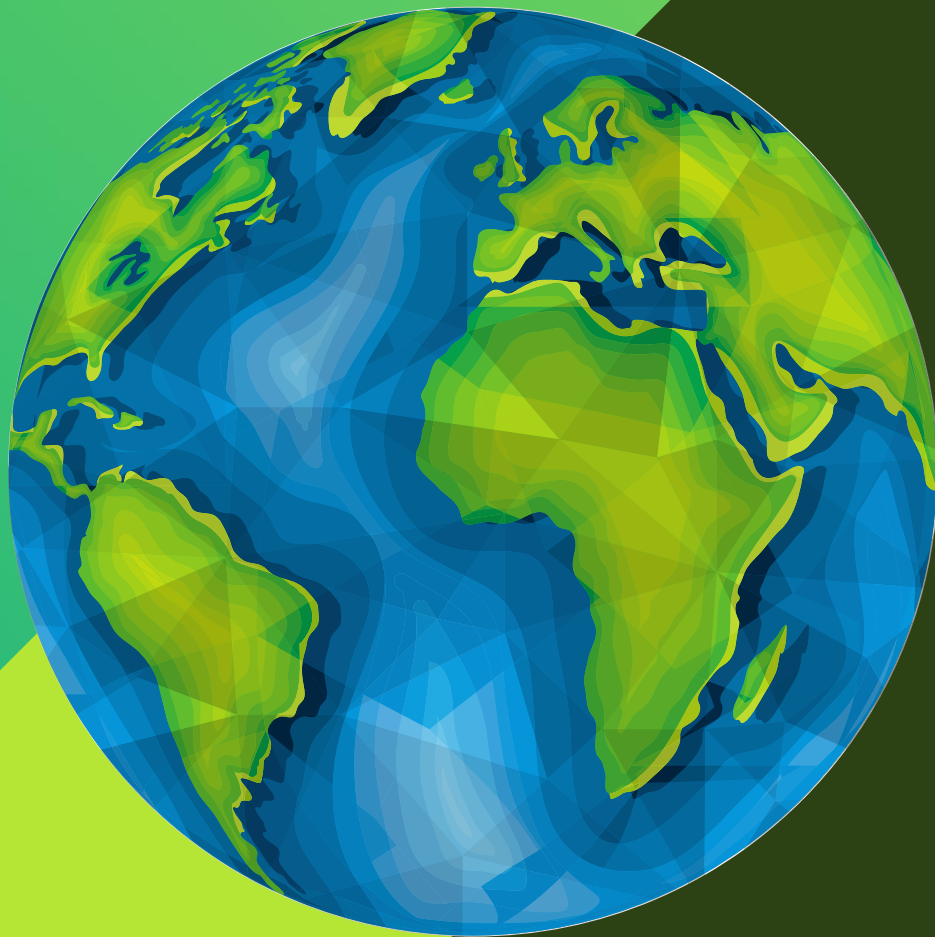

COP 28 UAE

Daily report of the main events.

Period: 12/12



WHAT WAS MOST EXPECTED ON THE DAY?

- One of the central points awaited during the last day of COP 28 was the definition of the commitments that member countries would assume in relation to the future of fossil fuels.



THE MAIN DEFINITIONS MADE

- The final text summarizing the Dubai climate negotiations was released, proposing that nations transition towards reducing the use of fossil fuels in energy systems. The document highlights the urgency of implementing significant, agile and continuous reductions in carbon emissions. Such actions are considered essential to contain the increase in global temperature and reach the target of 1.5°C, highlighting the need to face climate change.
- The document also provides for a fund of 420 million dollars to support countries most affected by global warming.



WHAT WAS UNDEFINED

- The final text received criticism, as it does not address details on how the energy transition will be carried out, lacking information on the financial resources involved. Notably, it does not mention the complete elimination of fossil fuels. Additionally, no specific goals or deadlines were stipulated for carrying out this process.



WHAT IMPACT BRAZIL

- Belém (PA) was officially confirmed as the official venue for COP 30 in 2025.
- Norway announced a donation of US\$50 million to the Amazon Fund, recognizing the drop in deforestation in 2023.
